

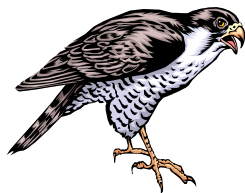

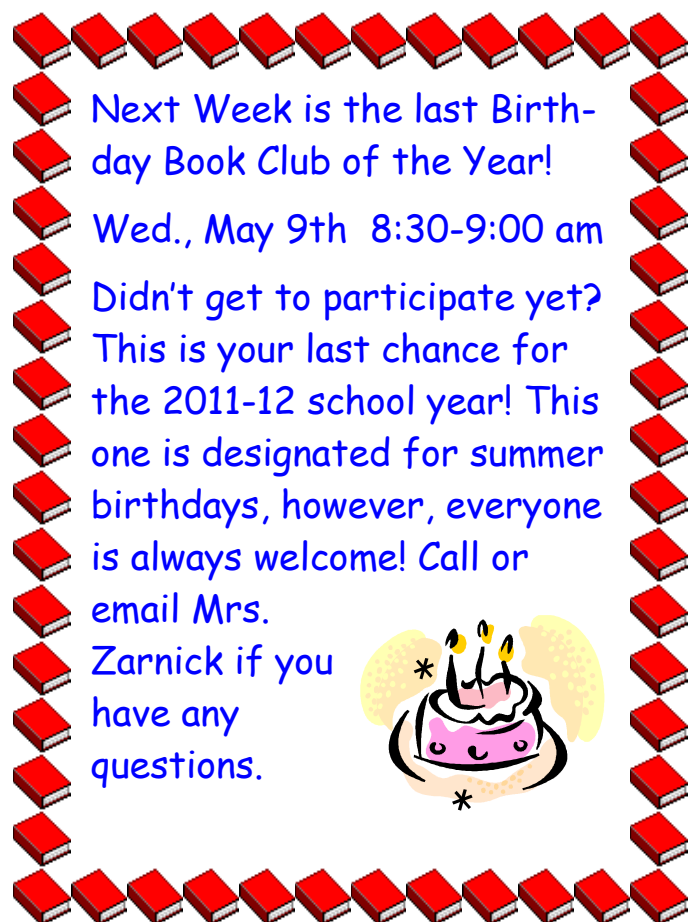
ECEAP preschool accepting applications for the 2012-2013 school year.
