**Intervention System at Gateway:** We are committed to helping students reach high standards of achievement. While many of our interventions happen at the classroom level with specific teachers, our school-wide system of interventions allows students to receive help on class work, assessments, critical skills, and homework both during the school day and after school. Below is a description of each school-wide intervention.

**Study Club:** Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday; 2:50-4:00 PM; Library  
Open to all students; some will be required to attend by teachers  
Staffed by: Certificated teacher and Educational Assistant  
Sign-in sheet required to ride 4:00 PM bus home.  
Focus: work completion, study skills, organizational assistance

**Math Club:** Tuesdays & Thursdays; 2:50-4:00 PM; Room 412-413  
Open to all students; some will be required to attend by teachers  
Staffed by: Certificated math teacher  
Sign-in sheet required to ride 4:00 PM bus home.  
Focus: math work completion; pre-teaching and re-teaching of critical skills; assessments

**School day-embedded interventions:** Monday-Friday during grade level lunch periods

1. *Organizational Lunch:* Mondays & Fridays  
Staffed by: Educational Assistant  
Students are referred by administration based on grades and teacher feedback.  
Focus: getting and staying organized; strengthening study skills; work completion
2. *Math Academic Lunch:* Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday  
Staffed by: Educational Assistant  
Students are referred by math faculty based on formative assessments and grades.  
Focus: Skill-building on critical grade level concepts; pre-teaching and re-teaching
3. *Mentoring Lunch:* Periodic basis  
Staffed by: District-approved volunteers; Gateway staff & faculty  
Students are referred by counselors & administrators  
Focus: social skill building, goal-setting, motivation, friendships
